Advantages and Disadvantages of FDA-Approved HIV Assays ...

- FDA-approved for HIV-1 only
- When used with plasma, less sensitive in detect-ing near the time of infection than other IgM/IgG tests and Ag/Ab tests
- Results from specimens collected using the OraSure oral fluid collection device have reduced sensitivity and specificity compared with blood specimens⁴

Understanding Microbiological Sampling and Testing

•Advantages: -Allows easy inexpensive quantitative analysis •Disadvantages: -Accommodates only a very small test portion -Higher LOD (ie, often 100 CFU/g) not suitable for detecting low levels of pathogens •Application: -Expedient for higher level analytes (eg, indicators, Campylobacter, S aureus, C perfringens, B cereus)
