Use a colon—not a semicolon—when what follows the punctuation restates what comes before o There are two things I need to do today: call my mother and feed the cat Use commas to separate items in a list if none of the items in the list require commas too

Semicolons, Colons, and Dashes

The use of the semicolon adds better distinction between the different elements in the list 2 COLONS: Colons (:) are used to introduce lists, explanations, examples, or quotations Colons can be used to introduce lists but not when following a verb Example: • Janice needs to pack three things for the trip: sunglasses, pizza, and sunscreen

Semicolons, Colons, and Dashes

But colon usage is more specific than semicolon usage When using a colon, the phrase that comes before the colon should always be a complete sentence What comes after the colon will vary Here is a good rule of thumb: if you can replace a colon with “namely” or “that is” you are using it correctly, although this is not always true

Use a semicolon to separate closely related independent clauses (complete sentences) If no punctuation is used between the clauses, a run-on or fused sentence is created If a comma is used between the clauses, a comma splice is created If the two clauses do not have related ideas, each sentence should be considered a separate sentence 2

Semicolons

The semicolon may be the most misunderstood punctuation mark of all It is often confused with other punctuation marks, particularly the colon and the comma In actuality, however, the semicolon has only two uses: to join complete sentences and as a "super-comma" Semicolons To Connect

Colons, semicolons, and dashes

- A colon is used to introduce a list, a quotation or a second clause that makes the first clause easier to understand (A clause is a group of words with a verb in it)
- A semicolon is used to link complete clauses that are too closely related to separate with a period It can also be used to separate items in a list that already has commas

Semi-colons, colons, and dashes

The semi-colon looks like a comma with a period above it, and this can be a good way to remember what it does A semi-colon creates more separation between thoughts than a comma does but less than a period does Here are the two most common uses of the semi-colon: To help separate items in a list, when some of those items already contain commas
