HOW TO COLLECT FUNGI FOR IDENTIFICATION Collect only the specimens you need – do not waste fruiting bodies Cut specimens from wood Dig specimens out of the ground – do not cut off at ground level Lay face down in a collection basket or box Identify accurately every cap before cooking DO NOT EAT RAW MUSHROOMS COLLECTED FROM THE WILD
