memory (fixed-mindset ideas), while a second group learned that intelligence, like a muscle, grows stronger through exercise (growth-mindset ideas) The group that re-ceived the growth-mindset messages greatly improved in the areas of motivation and math grades; students in the control group showed no improvement despite the other interventions

Implementing Differentiated Instruction by Building on ...

federal policies such as No Child Left Behind (2002) and Common Core State Standards (2010), limit the classroom teacher's flexibility (Cochran-Smith & Lytle, 2006) These government policies expect students to master a standards-based curriculum As a result, teachers tailor lessons to meet standards-based requirements over meeting the unique
