Speech and language skills vary greatly among children with Down syndrome Overall, the development of speech and language skills is delayed compared to typically developing peers Many children with Down syndrome develop non-verbal skills, such as gesturing and sign, earlier than they develop verbal communication skills

Down syndrome is the most common chromosomal abnormality in humans Down syndrome occurs in every 600-800 live births, and is not related to race, nationality, religion or socioeconomic status While the age of the mother can be a factor, 80% of people with Down syndrome are born to parents

### **Signing Documents When Physically Unable**

notary may sign on your behalf under the following conditions: 1 You are disabled and unable to sign the document 2 The notary must have satisfactory evidence that you are physically unable to sign your name or to make your mark and you are otherwise mentally competent 3 The notary's statement must state that the signature was obtained
