Infant/Toddler Classrooms How To Use This Tool To Identify ...

Playing peek-a-boo Listening to and saying nursery rhymes Saying and waving hellos/ good byes Playing with toys that make noise or squeak Looking at family photos Finger drawing in pudding, yogurt, or finger paint Scribbling with crayons or markers Looking at picture books Looking at catalogs, magazines, or newspapers

TEACHER OBSERVATION IN PRESCHOOLS (TOP) With ...

LISTENING (L) Teacher/Assistant is listening to another person (cell phones, PA system, TVs, and other electronic sources of sound do NOT count in coding Listening) TO WHOM IS THE TEACHER/ASSISTANT TALKING OR LISTENING? NO TALK/LISTEN (NT) Not talking or listening to anyone CHILD (C) One child SMALL GROUP (SG) Group of children (more than one)
