I made 13 rows (this is how you should count in peyote stitch) - When you want to finish your work, pass through few beads zig-zag (red arrow), then 'make a turn': pass down one bead/row (yellow arrow) and again pass zig-zag through few beads Finally, 'make a turn': pass down 1 bead/row (white arrow) and pass zig-zag through few beads

The Colinette Silk Tao in fresco reminds me of the first flowers that open on the foothills in the spring Starting with a simple fan-lace pattern from Jan Eaton's Encyclopedia of Crochet Techniques (Running Press, 2006), I made an openwork scarf that looks like spring and still chases the lingering chill Finished Size: olinette 2¾

Sewing Basics - Basting

made, sew the seam with a normal stitch length of 24mm Manual Basting Stitch: Many Janome machines have the manual basting stitch This is a quick way to baste large pieces together with long stitches that will remove easily This is especially useful to create a quilt sandwich This stitch is easy to find in machines with sewing applications

Operation Manual

Push this lever to stitch in the reverse direction 0 Buttonhole fine-adjustment screw (Page 27) A Pattern selection dial (Page 9) Rotate the dial in either direction to choose the stitch you want B Handwheel Used to manually raise and lower the needle C Main power and sewing light switch (Page 7) You can turn the main power and sewing light

stitch from inside the circle toward the outside of the circle (see diagrams H & I) All the stitches should now have yarn through them 4 Turn the handle clockwise and drop all the stitches off the hooks 5 For an open ended tube: Take the threaded sewing needle and stitch back through a few of the last stitches to secure the end of the yarn
