Try to have enough toys so that the toys can be rotated through cleanings • Limit use of common spaces o When possible, divide large group spaces to allow more children to safely use the space For example, use child-sized furniture, such as rolling shelves and kitchenettes, to divide a room and prevent mixing between groups of children
