The majority of wildlife rehabilitators in North America have independent home-based facilities Some may admit a wide range of species, ages, and health conditions Others may specialize in certain types of animals, such as swallows, hummingbirds, bats, or squirrels Some further restrict their rehabilitation to either juvenile or adult animals
