Crisis Intervention with Youth at Risk for Suicide

Current Statistics • In the United States, suicide is 3rd leading cause of death among 10-14 year- olds and the 2nd leading cause of death among 15-24 year olds (CDC, 2017) • 172% of adolescents in the US report seriously considering suicide and 74% report a suicide attempt in the past year (Kann, 2018) • The prevalence of both suicidal ideation (SI) and suicide attempts (SA)

A SUICIDE PREVENTION TOOLKIT Self-harm and Suicide

Although self-harm is not the same as suicide, self-harm can escalate into suicidal behaviours The intent to die can change over time One study found that almost half of people who self-harm reported at least one suicide attempt (Klonsky, 2011) Self-harm can also lead to suicide when: • Self-harm is no longer an effective coping method

Youth Suicide Prevention

Youth suicide is a growing health crisis in California. The annual number of suicides of youth ages 12 to 19 increased by 15 percent statewide from 2009 to 2018. In addition, instances of youth committing acts of self-harm—behavior that is self-directed and deliberately results in injury—increased by 50 percent during the same period.
